Background

We are working to make better conditions of the Sinegal village community in the Kavre district, near Banepa. We're assisting in the development of effective agricultural methods. We will be developing environmental awareness and community forestry. We are working together with the local community to build a community house that can be used for various activities or for shelter in case of emergency. The Sinegal village is located in the Kavre district, at an altitude of 1800 m, about 30 km east of Kathmandu. Our activities take place around Banepa, a town just an hour bus ride away from Kathmandu. Nature is all around and the air here is far better than in the bustling capital. Banepa offers amenities like restaurants with Wi-Fi, pharmacies, grocery stores, etc. After the earthquake, a lot of buildings were destroyed. The local population needs help in the rebuilding of the village.

- Building a water tank and a well, for clean water access

- Construction of a seniors home, organization of daily activities for seniors, creation of a garden near the community house - Help with the empowerment of women, to prepare them for the job market

- Further develop the community house, with the creation of a rooftop space to be used as meeting space
- Making fire line(fire break) surrounding community forest

- Reconstruct Hindu temple in the Banepa village

- Construction of a wall around the local primary school
- Repair of wooden shelters for the local community

The Daman project is one of our newest projects and we have only been operating here since 2012. Daman is quite isolated and most people are farmers, living a traditional life, as they have done for generations. However, times are changing and the community has a severe lack of funds to keep up with the rapid changes that Nepal is undergoing.

Knowledge of other cultures and the ability to speak English are vital skills for young Nepalese people. Many look forward to a future in the tourism business, and therefore the ability to communicate effectively with foreigners will increase their chances of having a better life once they leave the village. We also believe that our volunteers benefit a lot from staying in Daman. Living in a completely different culture with local hosts and adjusting to their conditions is an unforgettable experience. Teaching locals to think in new and different ways is their benefit, learning from their unique way of life is yours.

Our main aim is therefore to make life easier and more enjoyable particularly for the youth in Daman by giving them better prospects for the future through improving the facilities and the teaching at the local high school, where volunteers will mainly built up sport facilities. Moreover, volunteers will help with the construction of a community house. It is meant to provide space for events, like marriages and community meetings. But the space can be used in a variety of ways.

What to bring:

Seasonal clothes, sleeping bag, work shoes and gloves, raincoat if summer, work clothes, musical instruments, games, recipes, pictures of your home country. Pencils, pens, books, notebooks, textbooks for the local children are highly appreciated and can be bought in Kathmandu before departing for the camp. Requirement Positive attitude, respect and an open mind are all that is required **Accommodation**: Simple accommodation in a local family. This is great way to gain an insight view into the Nepalese culture and enjoy the friendliness of the people here. Volunteers will have three traditional meals a day, mostly the Nepalese national dish *Dhal Bhat* and take part in the cooking process
